Responsibilities of Finance Committee

- The Finance Committee is responsible for reviewing and approving the budget prior to the annual meeting of the Board. Expenses that exceed budgeted amounts by \$250 shall be approved in advance by the Finance Committee.
- The Finance Committee will perform an annual financial review prior to the Annual Meeting. Results will be presented at the Annual Meeting (when practical).
