



boards. The District 6 pair had been leading after Saturday's qualifying round handily when they put up a 68.46% first final session. Their second final session was only 50.08%, but they didn't need much by then.

They won an NAOBC 0–1500 Knockout in 2021, but it is their first NABC win. Both were extremely tired afterward.

Flight B is limited to players with under 2500 masterpoints and pairs must qualify out of their districts to compete in the event.



by one-third of a matchpoint -1/75th of a board. They had been second after Saturday's qualifying round by a hair, neck and neck with another pair from District 24. In the final sessions they scored 60.13% and 57.54%, putting them ahead by the thinnest of margins.

In second were Ryan Fu of Urbana IL and Kyle Blocher of Champaign IL, representing District 8. They had been seventh after qualifying and scored 65.68% and 57.38%.

It's the first NABC win for Xu and Li.

"I'm so excited," said Li, who was playing at his first NABC. Xu played in the Youth NABC in 2019, the last year he was eligible.

Though last summer's Grand National Teams Flight C featured an all-District 24 final, Xu and Li were not on either team. Both moved to New York a year ago and were not playing in District 24 at the time GNT qualifying was held. D24 pairs also finished fifth and 11th in NAP-C.

"They're all really good players," Xu said. "That's how I know being in C doesn't necessarily mean you aren't good players.

Li didn't think they were doing very well in the final session, but Xu said he felt good enough to bid some risky games.
